Re: Black Hills Federal Credit Union Comments on Proposed Rule Part 740.

Dear Ms. Rupp:

Black Hills Federal Credit Union wishes to express the following comments regarding the proposed changes to Rule Part 740, Revisions to the Official Sign Indicating Insured Status.

The 60 day time frame is reasonable to implement required sign changes to teller stations, buildings, doors, the web site, and print ads. However, it is unreasonable to require thousands of printed materials to become obsolete 60 days after the effective date. I believe a longer time period should be allowed so we may continue to use our current supply of printed materials bearing the NCUA logo. A period of at least 6 months from the time the new logo is released should be sufficient to use our current supply of printed materials. Please consider the monetary burden this will impose when developing the Final Rule on Part 740.
