My comments are fairly simple and straightforward. At a time when all credit unions are experiencing shrinking margins and doing their best to cut expenses, we believe it is unnecessary and non-productive to recreate many marketing and operational forms to comply with a simple language change in the insurance sign. Also, I would suggest a period of longer than 60 days to "exhaust" our current supplies. As a sound financial practice, we order supplies to last longer than 60 days and I would recommend a period of one (1) year to have all printed materials in compliance.
