



3. Pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1785(d)(3) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(b), whoever knowingly violates paragraph 1 or 2 above is subject to a fine of not more than \$1 million for each day such prohibition is violated, or imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, or both;



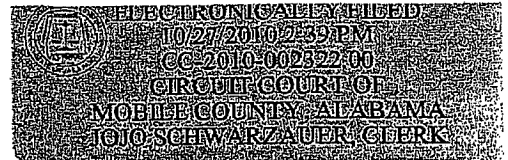
5. This Notice of Prohibition shall be effective and enforceable on the date of set forth below.

ORDER

Defendant waived trial by jury and defendant withdrew plea of not guilty and plead guilty; and was adjudged guilty.

The Court having ascertained in open court that, (1) the defendant understands her constitutional rights, the nature of the crime charged in this indictment, and the consequences of her guilty plea, and (2) the defendant understandingly and voluntarily waives her constitutional rights and pleads guilty.

It is further ordered that the defendant be and is hereby adjudged guilty of Identity Theft for which he was indicted, and is now sentenced by the Court to imprisonment in the penitentiary of the State of Alabama for the term of (10) ten years.

Defendant to be given credit for \_\_\_\_\_ time spent in jail.

On recommendation of the State; Execution of sentence is hereby suspended pending the good behavior of the defendant for a period of (5) five years, and at the expiration of said (5) five year period said suspension is hereby made permanent.

Suspension of sentence is further conditioned on defendant paying restitution in the amount of \$43,234.44 to USA Federal Credit Union, 103 Hillcrest Rd, Mobile, AL 36608 through the clerk's office and \$50.00 VCA and
