To the Governor of the Farm Credit Administration:

We, the undersigned, with the common bond of association indicated hereafter, do hereby apply for permission to organize and to operate a Federal credit union for the purposes indicated in and in accordance with the provisions of Public Act No. 467 of the 73d Congress entitled "An Act to establish a Federal Credit Union System, to establish a further market for securities of the United States and to make more available to people of small means credit for provident purposes through a national system of cooperative credit, thereby helping to stabilize the credit structure of the United States"; we agree to comply with the requirements of said Act, with the terms of this organization certificate and with all laws, rules and regulations applicable now or later to Federal credit unions; and we hereby certify that:

(5) The proposed field of membership will be limited to those having the following common bond of association, occupation or residence

Employees of the War Department in Washington, D.C., (exclusive of the Adjutant General's Office); members of their immediate families; and any association of such employees.

(6) The term of this credit union's existence shall be perpetual; provided, however, that the Governor of the Farm Credit Administration may suspend or revoke this organization certificate upon his finding that this credit union is bankrupt or insolvent or has violated any provision of this organization certificate, of the bylaws, of the Federal Credit Union Act including any amendments thereto or thereof, or of any regulations issued thereunder.

(7) This certificate is made to enable the undersigned to avail themselves of the advantages of said Act.

(8) The management of this credit union, the conduct of its affairs, and the powers, duties and privileges of its directors, officers, committees and membership shall be as set forth in these attached bylaws and any amendments thereto or thereof approved by the Governor of the Farm Credit Administration.
