Dear Director Vought:

The *Government Charge Card Abuse Prevention Act of 2012*¹ (Charge Card Act) mandates that Inspectors General conduct periodic risk assessments of agency purchase and travel cards to develop a plan to determine the scope, frequency, and number of Inspector General audits or reviews of agency purchase and travel cards. The Charge Card Act also mandates that Inspectors General report to the Director of the Office of Management and Budget on agency progress in implementing audit recommendations. This letter responds to this reporting requirement for our office, the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) Office of Inspector General.

During fiscal year 2025, we did not issue any reports with recommendations related to the NCUA's charge card programs. In addition, there were no open recommendations to close in 2025. In accordance with the Charge Card Act, we are currently conducting an audit of the NCUA's travel card program. We plan to report this work to the agency later this year.
